



Cottage Cove Urban Ministries Board Selection Criteria

The Board of Directors and the Executive Director are responsible for recruiting subsequent and additional members to serve on the Board of Directors. In furtherance of the ministry and defined purpose of Cottage Cove, prospective board members shall meet the following criteria:

Cottage Cove is a Christian faith-based organization. Board members will be men and women of integrity, Christians in belief and practice (in agreement with our statement of faith), committed to supporting and furthering the twin purposes of Cottage Cove. Each will use their sphere of influence and contacts to create awareness of this ministry, which together with personal involvement will actively engender further support and maintain the financial wellbeing of this ministry. Board members will endeavor to remain informed about the ongoing ministries and programs of Cottage Cove, with an objective of being both a source and evaluator of ideas. Specifically, each will actively participate in at least two or more Board meetings each year, and will be involved in at least one fundraising event annually. In order to maintain an independent and diverse Board, members will be at arms length from each other and, where possible, will represent a wide diversity of professions and church affiliations. Ethnic diversity is likewise desirable and welcome.
